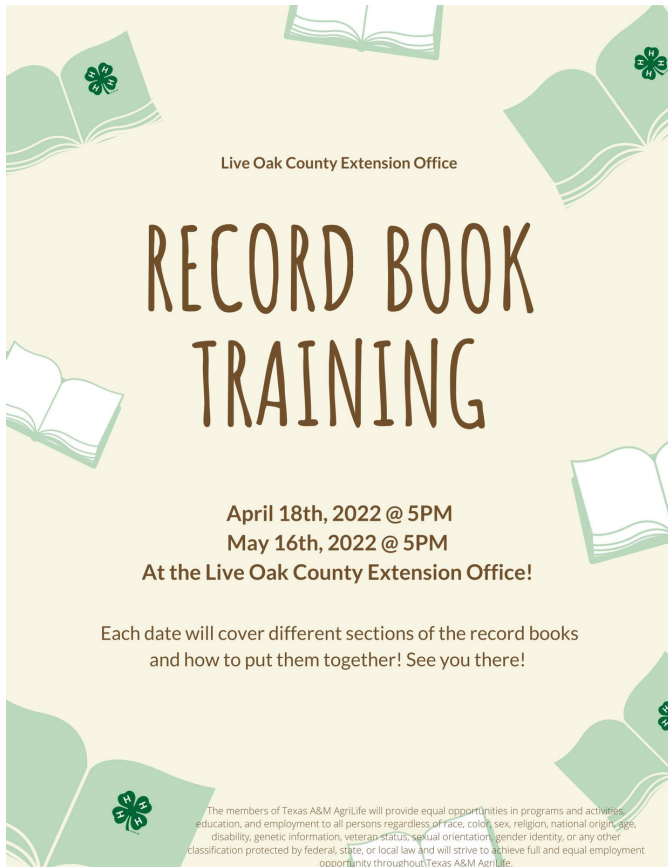


Live Oak County 4-H
